When you are preparing for an international business trip, Braintree Rehabilitation Hospital's Travel Medicine Clinic offers everything they need. More than just vaccinations, our Clinic, led by Travel Medicine expert Dr. James McEleney, offers consultation, advice, and individualized risk assessment in preparation for international travel. Dr. McEleney is aware of the most current, ever changing travel related health issues that may affect your international travel.

We recommend calling, when possible, at least three weeks prior to departure, but we are happy to help meet more urgent timelines as well.

Our Travel Medicine Clinic provides:

- **All Necessary and Required Pre-travel Immunizations** – including yellow fever and Japanese encephalitis, as well as more common immunizations like hepatitis A. You will receive the PHS 731 form required for entry into some countries.
- **Individualized Risk Assessment** – based upon health history, destination, planned activities, and length of stay
- **Advice and Prescriptions for avoiding Infectious Diseases and Environmental Risks**
- **Advice for Travelers with Particular Medical Issues** – including diabetics, pregnant travelers, and travelers taking medications that may impact travel risk
- **Pre- and Post-travel Counseling**

Dr. McEleney is a member of the International Society of Travel Medicine (ISTM) and the American Society of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene (ASTMH).
